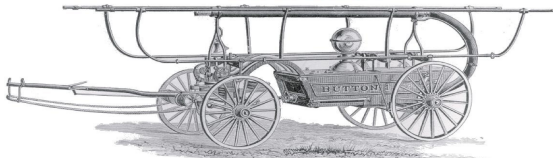

You can sign up to camp by group by filling out this form and mailing it back to the Museum (address below). There will be port-a-potties and sinks available to campers, but no showers. Those camping do so at their own risk. Please note that the camping area is in a town park and no alcohol or open fires will be permitted. Port-o-potties are provided, we ask that everyone use them and not the grass, please remind your crews that there are houses nearby.

NEW- no vehicles will be allowed on the field at anytime this year. All tents must be set up on the field (inside the fence) and not along the road. All vehicles must be moved Saturday morning to the appropriate parking lot and cannot remain along the road.
